AN ORDER concerning the Petition for Inquiry filed by Fred C. Russell concerning Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District in Groundwater Management Area 12; TCEQ Docket No. 2018-0194-MIS


On May 9, 2018, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (“Commission”) timely considered during its open meeting the Petition for Inquiry filed by Fred C. Russell concerning Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District in Groundwater Management Area 12. The Petition was evaluated under the requirements in the applicable statutes, including Texas Water Code Section 36.3011, and the Commission’s rules, including Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 293.23. The Commission also considered the responses to the Petition filed by the Executive Director, the Office of Public Interest Counsel, and Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District; the amicus responses filed by Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District and Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District, and the replies filed by Fred C. Russell.

After an evaluation of all relevant filings, the Commission determined to dismiss the Petition in accordance with Texas Water Code Section 36.3011(c) and Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 293.23(g).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that:

1. The Petition for Inquiry filed by Fred C. Russell concerning Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District in Groundwater Management Area 12 is DISMISSED; and
2. If any provision, sentence, clause or phrase of this Order is for any reason held to be invalid, the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Order.
