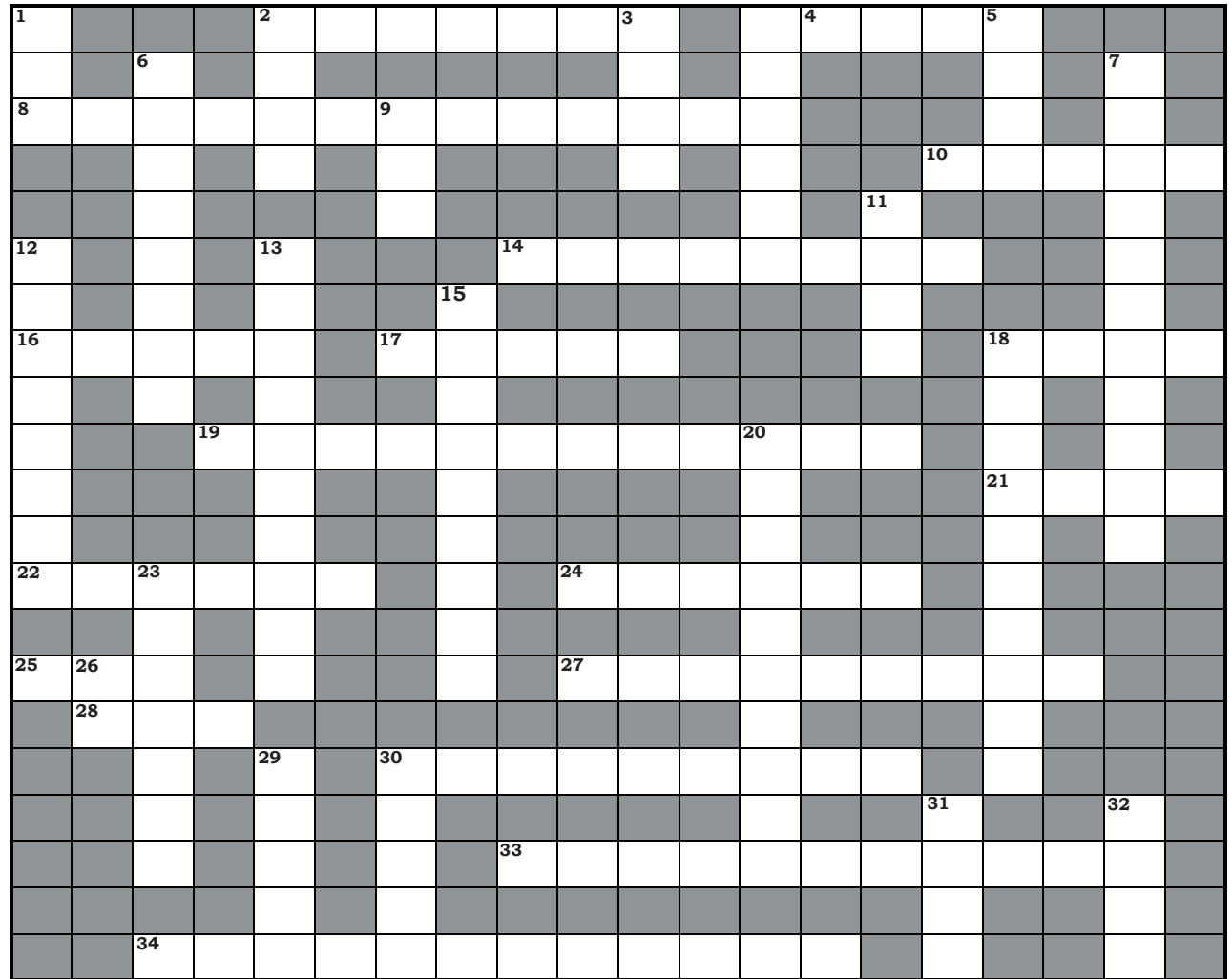

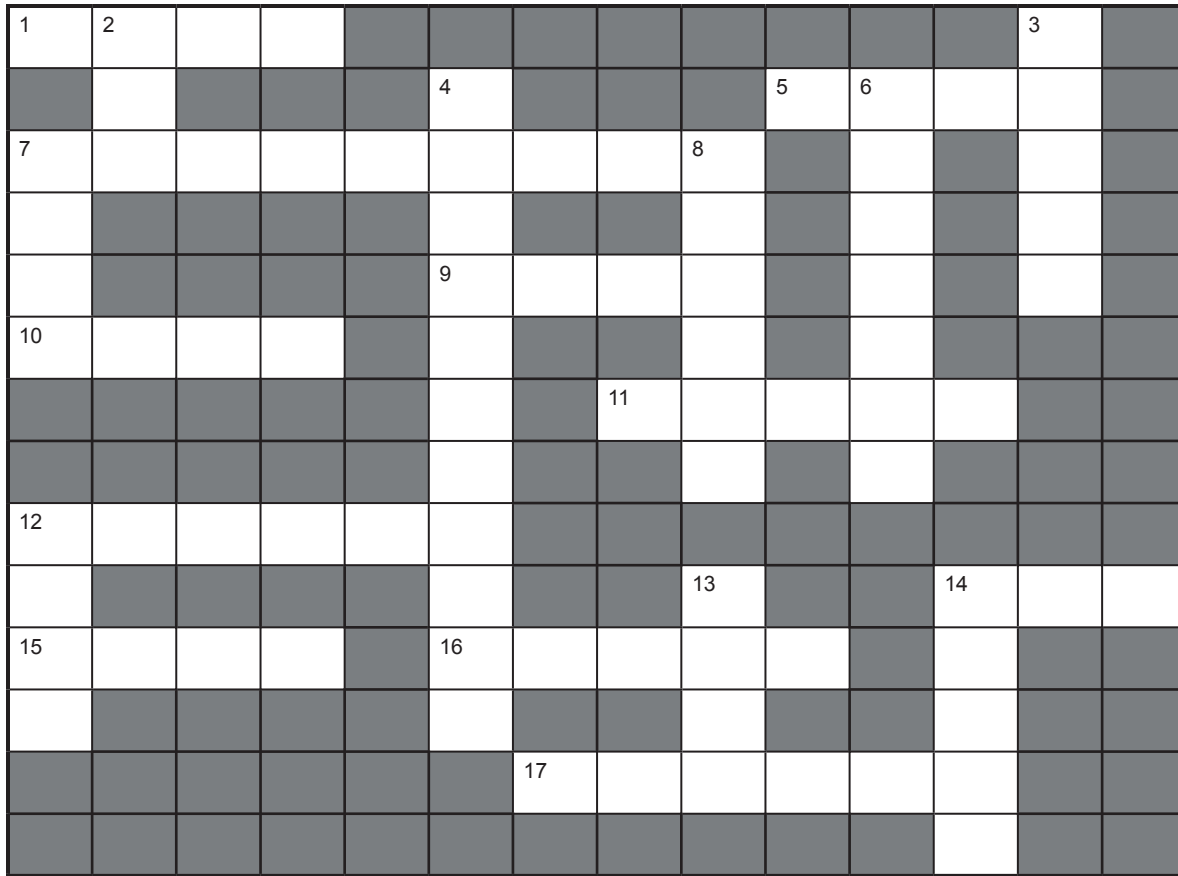

The largest nonstop rainstorm dumped 45 inches on Alvin during three days of July, 1979.

The nine major and 20 minor aquifers in the state produce enough water each day to fill a line of gallon jugs to the moon and back.

Texas has more than 5,700 reservoirs in the river system, however, a mere 74 of these contain 98% of the state's usable surface water supply.

The greatest official rainfall in one day was 29 inches in Albany, Texas in August, 1987, while unofficially the residents of Thrall reported 38 inches in 1921.
