

TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY



AN ORDER concerning the petition for inquiry filed by Curtis Chubb, Ph.D. pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 36.1082 and 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 293.23; TCEQ Docket No. 2015-0844-MIS.

On August 19, 2015, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) considered during its open meeting the petition for inquiry filed by Curtis Chubb, Ph.D. (Petitioner) pursuant to Tex. Water Code (TWC) § 36.1082 and 30 Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) § 293.23. The petition was evaluated under the requirements in the applicable statutes and Commission rules. The Commission also considered the responses to the petition filed by Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), Fayette County GCD, Gonzales County Underground Water Conservation District, Lost Pines GCD, Mid-East Texas GCD, Post Oak Savannah GCD, the Executive Director, and the Office of Public Interest Counsel; and the Petitioner's reply.

After evaluation of all relevant filings, the Commission decided to dismiss the petition.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that:

1. The petition for inquiry filed by Curtis Chubb, Ph.D. pursuant to TWC § 36.1082 and 30 TAC § 293.23 is hereby DISMISSED; and

2. If any provision, sentence, clause or phrase of this Order is for any reason held to be invalid, the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Order.
