5 FACTS ABOUT GROUNDWATER
CONSERVATION DISTRICTS:

1

GCDs are created, empowered, and governed by Texas Law, Ch. 36 of the Water Code as the State's preferred method of management of groundwater.

2

The Texas Water Development Board is charged with certifying GCD management plans.

3

State Law recognizes that a landowner owns the groundwater as real property and only a GCD has the authority to reasonably manage and limit production.

4

GCDs must use groundwater availability data that is acceptable to the Texas Water Development Board.

5

A GCD may not deny a permit based on the fact that the applicant seeks to transfer groundwater outside of the district.
