Summary Report of comments received for 2016 Proposed Desired Future Conditions for Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District in Groundwater Management Area 12

The 2016 Proposed Desired Future Conditions (DFC's) were made available to the public via the District website at www.mideasttexasgcd.com indicating that the commencement of receiving comments began on April 19, 2016. Posted on the website and available at the District office located at 101 West Main, Suite B22 Madisonville Texas was a copy of the 2016 Proposed DFC's as adopted by the Board of Directors. This document was also posted at the District's offices in Freestone and Leon Counties.

Additionally, an email was sent to all addresses defined as relevant pursuant to notice requests made to the District with the subject line "Notice to Receive Public Comments on Proposed DFC's for GMA 12". The date this email was sent was April 22, 2016.

The date of June 28, 2016 was established to hold a Public Hearing to hear any comments concerning the 2016 Proposed DFC's for the District. Notice of this public meeting was posted at the courthouses in Freestone, Leon and Madison counties on June 8, 2016 allowing 20 days for notice. Additionally, a Notice of Public Hearing was emailed to each newspaper of general circulation within the District to be included in their publication for the weeks of June 6-10 and June 13-17 in order to provide additional notice to area residents regarding the 2016 Proposed DFC's.

The Board of Directors met on Tuesday, June 28, 2016 at 6:00 pm in Madisonville, Texas. The meeting was held at the Madison County Courthouse, 101 W. Main and the meeting was held in the JP Courtroom, 1st Floor. At this meeting, the first order of business was a Public Hearing to receive comments for 2016 Proposed Desired Future Conditions for aquifers managed by the District. No comments were provided during the public hearing portion of the meeting.

The comment period, as indicated on the notices duly filed with the County Clerk's for Madison, Leon and Freestone counties, ended at the close of business on Monday, July 18, 2016.
