Consider Improvements to property This work is in conjunction with our very popular education efforts concerning rainwater harvesting classes and additional classes on plant selection and irrigation. The Advisory Committee received a presentation recently from Clover Cochran on this. We have approximately \$8000 available in the 2018 Budget for this work. The total for adding additional flower beds, purchase of materials and plants, etc., comes to \$3442, with additional amounts to be discussed for maintenance of the grounds.
