

**Report on current and future work by the POSGCD Community Outreach
Committee**

The Community Outreach Committee hosted two meetings in 2018. Meetings were April 24, 2018 and October 23. The following topics were discussed with citizens:

1. History and timeline of development of the District's Rules and Management Plan.
2. History and process of actions taken by Groundwater Management Area 12 in adoption of Desired Future Conditions.
3. Sections 4, 7, 14, and 16 of the District's Rules
4. Management of groundwater, including the MAG, with respect to achieving, but not exceeding, DFCs in the District.
5. Possible impacts to the Carrizo near Caldwell, and use of District resources to assist affected landowners.
6. Ways citizens are encouraged to participate in programs and management of resources by the District.
7. District Rules pertaining to curtailment of production permits.

The Committee also received a report from a master's student from Texas A&M on the Vista Ridge Pipeline at the October 23 meeting.
