A Public Hearing will be held in accordance with Section 7, Section 8 and/or Section 14, Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District Rules concerning Amendments to Existing Drilling and Operation Permit, POS-D&O/A&M-0001d, by Blue Water Vista Ridge, LLC. Any Contested Case Hearings shall follow the procedure set out in Section 14.5, POSGCD Rules. Opportunity for Public Comments in accordance with Section 551.007, Texas Government Code, on the Permit shall take place after the above-referenced, applicable procedures for the Public Hearing are completed but before the District's Board takes action.
