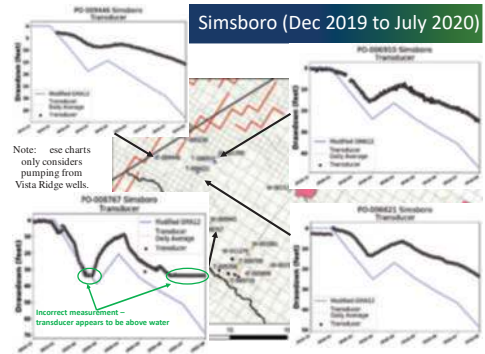

Update on Vista Ridge Production and Changes in Water Levels

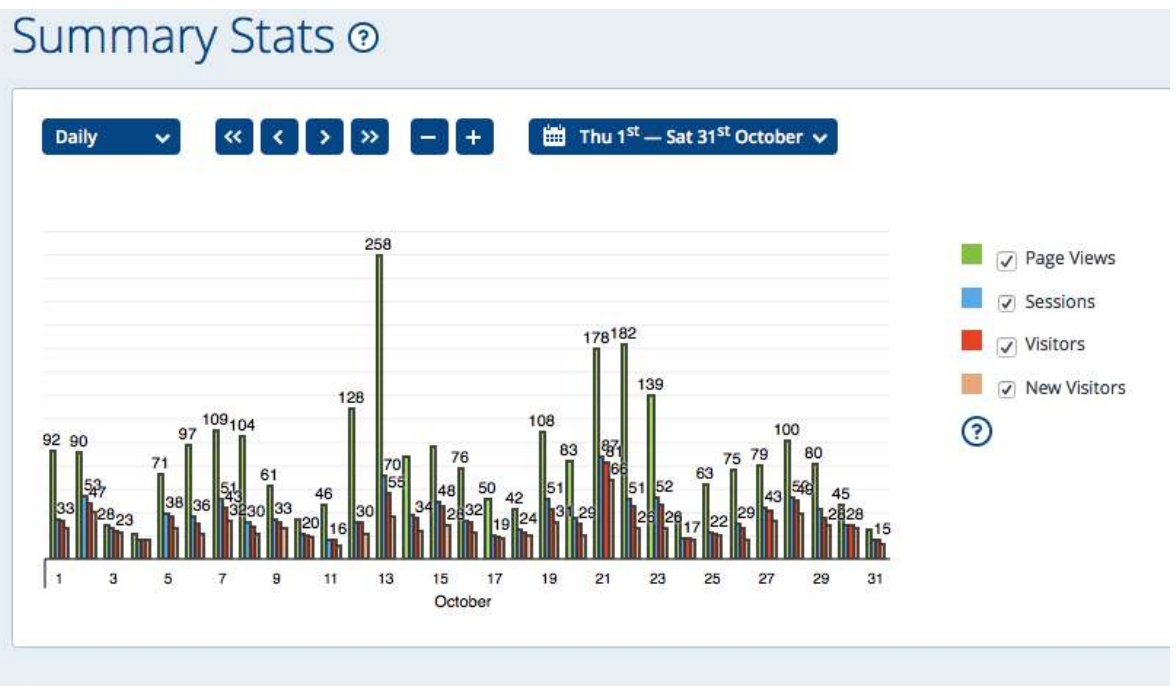
Under our State Constitution, landowners own the groundwater under their property and have the right to either pump that water or lease it to be pumped. Under current State law groundwater conservation districts (GCDs) are required to issue permits to allow that pumping to the point that the pumping achieves the Desired Future Condition established through joint planning with other GCDs which share a common aquifer.

One of the effects of these laws is that while some landowners choose to pump their property, others will see some impacts to the water levels in their wells due to a reduction in the pressure in the aquifer. Pressure is what pushes water up the pipe from the aquifer in a well. A reduction of pressure can occur near the vicinity of large pumping centers such as the Vista Ridge Project in western Burleson County. Even though the aquifer itself may remain fully saturated, when this pressure reduction occurs, water levels in nearby wells drop. When that occurs, the District has a program to assist well owners in that situation called the Groundwater Well Assistance Program (GWAP), which is discussed on page 2 of this newsletter.
