

# **Results of the Local Water Utilities Grant Program Survey-2024**

- \*\*All results are for individuals who responded to this survey\*\*
- 1. 100% of individuals who responded to this survey have received a grant from POSGCD in the past 5 years

## 2. How grant funds were utilized:

(Please note; some individuals who responded to this survey answered this question with multiple methods of how they heard about this program so total will exceed 100%)

- 87.5% used the Grant funds to replace obsolete water lines
- 37.5% used the Grant funds to replace obsolete water meters
- 25% used the Grant funds to install meters or water use measurement devices
- 12.5% used the Grant funds to refurbish water storage tanks or treatment facilities
- 12.5% used the Grant funds for a filtration system
- 3. 100% of individuals who responded to this survey stated that the Grant Program has assisted in providing improved public health and safety for citizens served by your utility.

#### 4. Assistance from District Staff:

- 87.5% were assisted by District Staff during the application process.
- 12.5% were not assisted by District Staff during the application process.
- 100% who were assisted by District Staff were either satisfied or very satisfied with the assistance provided.

## 5. Attendance a District Workshop or the District Summit:

- 87.5% stated someone from their utility has attended a District Workshop or the District Summit
- 12.5% stated they had not attended a District Workshop or the District Summit
- 100% who stated that someone from their utility has attended a District Workshop or the District Summit were either satisfied or very satisfied with the topics and information provided in the workshops or Summit.
